### **April 22, Wednesday, DAY 1: DEPART U.S.A.**

We depart on an overnight flight from San Antonio, Dallas, Houston, or Newark to Paris. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the flight. Quotes for add-on flights and Premium Economy or Business class are available upon request and will be quoted starting 120 days before departure. We work with group airfares, which do not permit seat selection. If you wish to reserve specific seats on the flights, we recommend purchasing your own airline tickets and the land-only option with us.

### **April 23, Thursday, DAY 2: WELCOME TO FRANCE – VISIT PARIS & START YOUR CRUISE**

Welcome to France. Upon arrival at the airport, we are greeted by our English-speaking French guides, who assist us onto the deluxe motor coaches. We celebrate Mass on Rue De Bac, in the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal, where we see the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure and visit the museum next door. In the afternoon, we board the ship and settle into our cabins. The entire ship is our home for the next seven nights, and is at our disposal to laugh, share, and enjoy meeting new friends, where we also experience new adventures. Tonight, we enjoy the “Paris by Night cruise” as we sail past beautifully lit-up monuments and watch the light show at the Eiffel Tower. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.D)

### **April 24, Friday, DAY 3: THE PALACE OF VERSAILLES**

Our Seine River cruise sails this morning through the lovely French countryside. Enjoy having morning coffee on the ship’s deck as we sail past lovely homes dotting the river banks. Today, we explore the opulent Palace of Versailles, built by King Louis XIV, also known as the “Sun King,” and a favorite hunting place of Marie Antoinette. We see the manicured gardens of Versailles, followed by a visit to the palace. We will be divided into smaller groups and given private headphones to tour the palace. Return to the ship for dinner and a relaxing evening in the lounge. Overnight on the ship. (B.L.D)

### **April 25, Saturday, DAY 4: ROUEN, THE CITY OF ST. JOAN OF ARC**

This morning, we arrive in the charming town of Rouen, which boasts a restored medieval quarter and the magnificent Gothic Cathedral of Notre-Dame, often depicted in the paintings of Claude Monet. Throughout

its turbulent history, the city was devastated several times, including during the Middle Ages, when a fire and the plague ravaged it. The English occupied it during the Hundred Years

War, when the French heroine Joan of Arc (Jeanne d’Arc) was tried for heresy and burned at the stake in the central square in 1431. During WWII, Allied bombing raids laid waste to large parts of the city, especially the area south of the Cathedral. Still, the town has been meticulously rebuilt over the last seven decades. We tour the city on foot and celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Joan of Arc. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D)

### **April 26, Sunday, DAY 5: NORMANDY, D-DAY BEACHES & AMERICAN CEMETERY**

After breakfast, we disembark and board our buses for a drive through the beautiful landscape of Normandy to the historic Normandy Beaches. The 54 miles of Atlantic stretching from Utah Beach in the west to Sword Beach in the east — are littered with WWII museums, monuments, cemeteries, and battle remains left in tribute to the courage of the British, Canadian, and American armies that successfully carried out the largest military operation in history: D-Day. On these serene beaches, at dawn on June 6, 1944, the Allies finally gained a foothold in France. From that historic moment, Nazi Europe was destined to crumble. We visit the American Memorial and Cemetery and place a wreath on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Nearby, we visit Omaha Beach and pay our respects to our brave, fallen soldiers with a prayer. Mass will be celebrated. Lunch today is not included and on our own. Return to the ship for dinner. (B.D)

### **April 27, Monday, DAY 6: LISIEUX, THE HOME OF ST. THERESE LITTLE FLOWER**

Today, we are in Lisieux, the home of St. Therese the Little Flower, where we visit the places associated with the life of the beloved saint. We see the Carmel Convent, Les Buissonnets, the humble dwelling of the Saint, and the magnificent Basilica of St. Therese, along with its crypt where we celebrate Mass. Return to the ship for dinner. (B.L.D)

### April 28, Tuesday, DAY 7: VERNON, CLAUDE MONET HOUSE AND GARDENS AT GIVERNY

After breakfast, we disembark in La Roche-Guyon and head to the lovely little town of Vernon. We celebrate Mass at the local French country church and then transfer to Giverny to visit the Claude Monet Estate, which includes the house where the famous artist lived, as well as his beloved gardens and ponds, from which he drew inspiration for his magnificent paintings of the water lilies. The famous Impressionist artist lived here for forty-three years, from 1883 to 1926. Walking through his house and gardens, we can still feel the atmosphere that reigned at the home when the artist lived here. Return to the ship for lunch and dinner. (B.L.D)

### April 29, Wednesday, DAY 8: HIGHLIGHTS OF PARIS

We wake up in Paris! Seeing the beautiful Eiffel Tower, Les Champs-Élysées, and other city highlights during a panoramic tour. We explore the newly renovated Notre Dame Cathedral, concluding our day in the Montmartre section, where we tour the magnificent Sacré-Cœur (Sacred Heart Basilica) in the city's bohemian quarter. We celebrate Mass before returning to the ship. Tonight, enjoy the gala farewell dinner followed by dancing in the lounge. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D)

### April 30, Thursday, DAY 9: DISEMBARK – RETURN TO USA

Following breakfast, we disembark from our ship, saying goodbye to the fantastic crew who hosted us and to the many friends we made this week. We transfer to the airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

### OPTIONAL EXTENSION TO LOURDES

#### April 30, Thursday, DAY 9: OUR LADY OF LOURDES

We are transferred to the train station this morning, where we board the comfortable TGV train to Lourdes. Upon arrival in Lourdes, we settle into our hotel and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Lourdes for Mass. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

#### May 1 & 2, Friday and Saturday, DAYS 10 & 11: LOURDES

We have two full days in Lourdes. We celebrate Mass at the Basilica, and have a walking tour of the Sanctuary, including the Grotto and the Basilica, and watch a video presentation that explains Lourdes's story in detail. Our group will see Boly Mill, the birthplace of St. Bernadette, and the Cachot, an abandoned prison where Bernadette's impoverished family lived. We pray the Stations of the Cross and attend the Blessing of the Sick in the afternoon. We have time for private prayer and reflection. In the evening, we join the Candlelight Procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

#### May 3, Sunday, DAY 12: RETURN TO THE USA

Early this morning, we are transferred to Toulouse airport, where we board our flights back to the United States. (B)

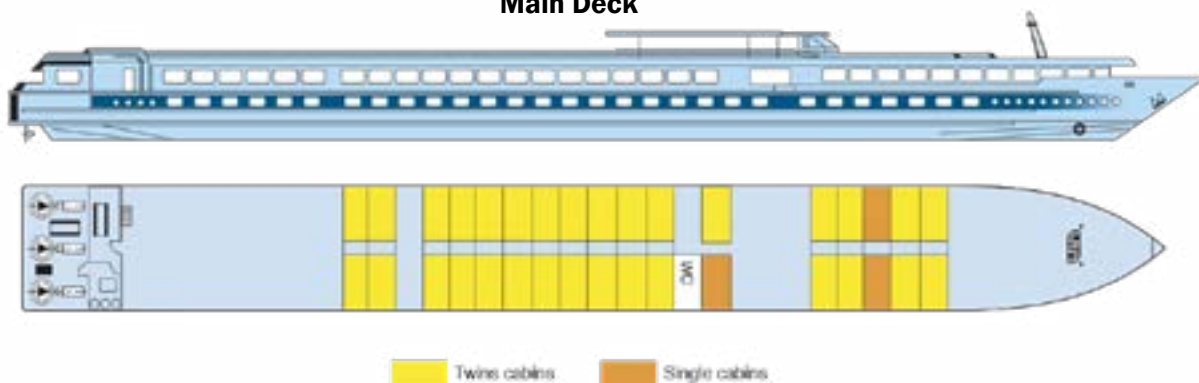

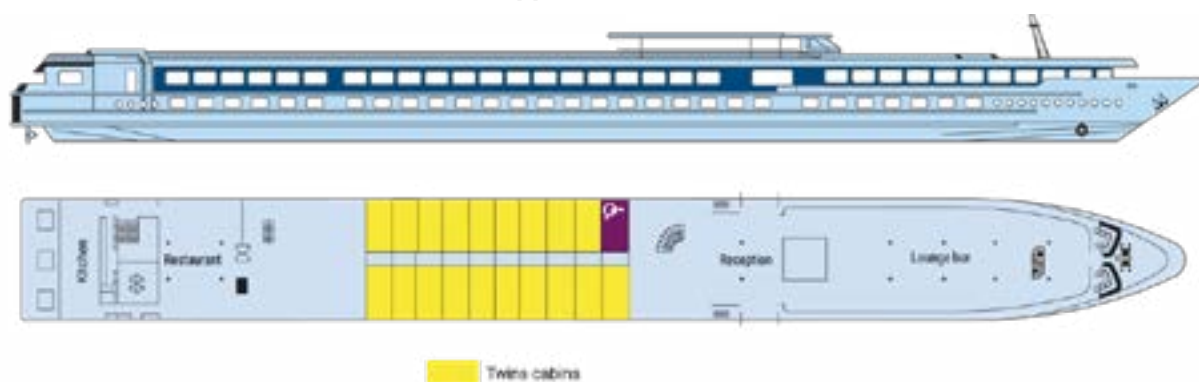
