January 8, Thursday, Day 1: DEPART USA TO CAIRO

Depart the USA on an overnight flight to Cairo. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the flight. Enjoy your flight as you look forward to your incredible pilgrimage journey. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request and will be provided starting 120 days before departure. Group air restrictions (for ten passengers traveling together) do not permit specific seating requests on flights. We recommend purchasing your own airline tickets and the land-only package with us if seat confirmation is an essential part of your trip. Should you require any additional information, please do not hesitate to contact your trip Account Manager, who will be happy to assist you.

January 9, Friday, Day 2: ARRIVAL IN CAIRO, EGYPT

Welcome to Egypt! We are met and assisted at the airport by our tour guide. Transfer to our hotel for a well-deserved night of rest. We gather for a welcome by our group leaders before our dinner at the hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Cairo. (D)

January 10, Saturday, Day 3: FLIGHT FROM CAIRO TO LUXOR - NILE CRUISE EMBARKATION

Following check-out, we transfer to the airport for our flight from Cairo to Luxor. We visit the Temple of Karnak, the world's second-largest ancient religious site after Angkor Wat. The Great Hypostyle Hall is comprised of columns in 16 rows that soar 80 feet into the air. As we wander among the 134 Columns, we'll be astounded at the details of carved hieroglyphs visible after thousands of years! Continue to the Temple of Luxor, where it is said that many of the Kings of Egypt were crowned. The boy King Tutankhamun and Ramses II built parts of the temple. Later this afternoon, we board our deluxe riverboat, which will be our home for the next four nights for our Nile Cruise. We are docked in Luxor overnight, so there is time to explore the city of Luxor and the markets lining the Nile this afternoon and evening. Dinner and overnight on the ship. Mass will be celebrated. (B.L.D)

January 11, Sunday, Day 4: LUXOR - ESNA

This morning, we visit the Valley of the Kings on the west bank of the Nile, then proceed to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, and on the way back to the ship, stop at the Colossi of Memnon, to see the two famous statues at the entrance of the temple of Amenhotep III. Our ship sails

to Esna, where we watch as the ship passes the magnificent Dam on the Nile. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight on board the ship. (B.L.D)

January 12, Monday, Day 5: EDFU - KOM OMBO - ASWAN

We sail to Edfu this morning, and upon arrival, we visit the Temple of Edfu, one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt. Dedicated to the falcon god Horus, it was buried under nearly 40 feet of drifting sand over the centuries. In 1860, a French Egyptologist began the work of freeing Edfu, resulting in it being nearly intact! Return to the boat and sail to the temple of Kom-Ombo, a unique double temple. Half is dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, and the other to the falcon god Horus. Continue our Nile cruise sailing to Aswan. No Mass will be celebrated today. Dinner and overnight on the ship. (B.L.D)

January 13, Tuesday, Day 6: ASWAN

Today, we visit the High Dam of Aswan and the Temple of Philae. The Aswan Dam was built during the 1960s. Before being built, the Nile River overflowed its banks yearly, and the dam protects the area from the flood/drought cycle and generates hydroelectric power. We then visit Philae, an island downstream from the Aswan Dam. Relocated before the dam was completed, the Temple of Isis was flooded for six months every year and was disassembled stone by stone and reconstructed. Return to the boat for lunch. Later this afternoon, sail the Nile on a traditional felucca used for centuries by the Nubian people of Egypt. Enjoy a visit to the Aswan Spice market this evening after our farewell dinner onboard the ship. Mass will be celebrated. (B.L.D)

January 14, Wednesday, Day 7: ASWAN - ABU SIMBEL -**CAIRO**

This morning, we say goodbye to the ship's crew, who took excellent care of us. We enjoy a tour of the Temples of Abu Simbel before we board our flight to Cairo, where we check into our hotel, which will be our home for the next 4 nights. Mass will be celebrated. (B.L.D)

January 15, Thursday, Day 8: THE PYRAMIDS - CAIRO

After breakfast, we visit Sakkara, the home of Egypt's oldest pyramid, constructed around 2,650 BC. Admire this incredible stepped structure as we learn how it was built for the Pharaoh Djoser, and enjoy time to explore at leisure. Following lunch in a local restaurant, we visit the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx, an archaeological site on the

Giza Plateau on the outskirts of Cairo, Egypt. This complex of ancient monuments includes the three pyramid complexes known as the Great Pyramids, the massive sculpture known as the Great Sphinx, several cemeteries, a workers' village, and an industrial complex. We have time to shop in the local bazaar before returning to our hotel. Mass will be celebrated in St. Joseph's Church. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Cairo. (B.L.D)

January 16, Friday, Day 9: CHRISTIAN CAIRO – ST. SIMON – GRAND MUSEUM

This morning we begin our tour of Cairo. Our visit focuses on Egypt's often overlooked, rich Christian history. Our guide will take us on a tour of Old Coptic Cairo, including the Hanging Church, the Apparition Church, the Holy Crypt, and the Abu Serga Church. We also visit the monastery of St. Simon el Mokkattam. In the afternoon, we explore sections of the newly renovated and reopened Grand Museum, the world's largest museum. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Cairo. (B.L.D)

January 17, Saturday, Day 10: EXCURSION TO WADI NATRUN DESERT MONASTERIES – SOUND AND LIGHT SHOW

Today, we drive to Wadi Natrun. We visit ancient monasteries with beautiful frescoes and icons, meet with monks, and explore the traditions of Egyptian monasticism. We have lunch in the area and drive back to the hotel. In the evening, after dinner, we enjoy the Sound and Light Show at the Pyramids. Dinner and overnight in Cairo. Mass will be celebrated. (B.L.D)

January 18, Sunday, Day 11: CAIRO - DEPARTURE

After breakfast this morning, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B)

OPTIONAL EXTENSION - MT. SINAI - ST. CATHERINE'S MONASTERY - THE DEAD SEA - PETRA - AMMAN

January 18, Sunday, Day 11: ST. CATHERINE'S MONASTERY

Following breakfast, we check out of our hotel and drive to St. Catherine's Monastery, taking the Moses Exodus Route through the Sinai Desert. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at St. Catherine's Monastery (simple accommodations). (B.L.D)

January 19, Monday, Day 12: MT. SINAI - TABA

Early this morning, we climb up to Mt. Sinai, where Moses received the Ten Commandments. We see the possible site of the Burning Bush where the Lord spoke to Moses, and enjoy a spectacular moment as we watch the sun rise over Mt. Sinai. We descend the mountain for breakfast at the hotel before visiting St. Catherine's Monastery and Museum. The monastery was dedicated to St. Catherine, who was tortured to death because she became a Christian. Our two-hour drive takes us to the seaside resort of Taba. Check into our hotel and enjoy the rest of the day on the shores of the Red Sea. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Taba. (B.L.D)

January 20, Tuesday, Day 13: TABA – AQABA – WADI RUM, JORDAN

We check out of our hotel and are transferred to the ferry, which takes us from Taba, Egypt, to Aqaba in Jordan, where we meet our Jordanian guide and bus. We explore the ruins of the Aqaba Church, a historic 3rd-century church unearthed in 1998 by a group of American archaeologists. It is considered to be the world's oldest-known purpose-built Christian church. Adventure awaits us in Wadi Rum, where we enjoy a jeep ride in the desert and an overnight in tents under the stars. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in the desert. (B.D)

January 21, Wednesday, Day 14: WADI RUM - THE DEAD SEA

This morning, we depart for the Dead Sea. We visit Mt. Nebo, the place where Prophet Moses gazed at the Promised Land before he died, and is alleged to be his burial place. We see the Plains of Moab to the north, the area where the tribes of Israel camped before crossing the Jordan River, and view Bethany beyond. We also visit the Baptismal site on the River Jordan, where tradition tells us Jesus was baptized. Then we visit the town of Madaba, where we find the famous 6th-century mosaic map of Palestine in St. George's Church. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at the Dead Sea. (B.L.D)

January 22, Thursday, Day 15: PETRA -

We drive on the King's Highway to Petra, where we enjoy a sightseeing tour of magnificent Petra, one of the wonders of the world. A visit to this ancient Nabatean City, carved out of red rose rock, includes the Treasury, Monastery, and Theatre. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Amman. (B.L.D)

January 23, Friday, Day 16: RETURN TO USA

We are transferred to the airport for our flight home to the USA. (B)


