### November 27, Friday, DAY 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart from New Orleans on an overnight flight to Vienna. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. Due to group air restrictions, we cannot request specific seat assignments on flights. If a specific seat location is important to you, please purchase the Land Only package and plan to book your own air.

## November 28, Saturday, DAY 2: VIENNA – CRUISE EMBARKATION

Upon arrival in Vienna, we board our motorcoach and head to the Polish Church to celebrate Mass. We explore the small museum of St. John Paul II relics and the lovely little gift shop. Following lunch at one of Vienna's Christmas markets, we board our cruise ship. Unpack and settle into our comfortable home for the next four nights. Enjoy a welcome cocktail and dinner followed by music in the lounge. Overnight on the cruise. (D)

#### November 29, Sunday, DAY 3: VIENNA

Enjoy breakfast on the ship. Our buses take us to Mass at one of Vienna's most beautiful churches. During our panoramic tour of the Ringstrasse, we see the majesty of Imperial Vienna made even more beautiful by the festive Christmas decorations. We walk to St. Stephen's Cathedral (outside view), followed by a 90-minute guided walking tour of the city center, including Donner Fountain, Belvedere Palace Gardens, Hofburg Palace, and the Spanish Riding School (outside view). Stroll through the various Christmas markets located throughout the city, sipping mulled wine and tasting local delicacies. Return to the ship for dinner and entertainment. Overnight on the cruise. (B.D)

### November 30, Monday, DAY 4: BUDAPEST

We wake up in Budapest, Hungary. Following breakfast, we celebrate Mass and enjoy a walking tour of both sides of the city: Pest and Buda. We start with a visit to the Fisherman's Bastion, which takes its name from the guild of fishermen responsible for defending this stretch of city walls in the Middle Ages. Visit the breathtaking Matthias Church and take in the amazing view of the city from the hill. Our exploration of this beautiful city includes a visit to Heroes' Square and St. Stephen's Basilica on the Pest side of the city. The bus drops us off at Vorosmarty Square to see the Christmas markets there and by the Basilica. Enjoy exploring and browsing the various stalls filled with ornaments, gifts, cookies, food, and decorations. If you get tired of the festivities at the markets, take a soak in the famous Gellert Spa (reservations required). Return to the ship for dinner, followed by a folklore show. After the show, enjoy one of the highlights of the cruise as we see Budapest by night from our ship. Overnight on the cruise. (B.D)

### December 1, Tuesday, DAY 5: BRATISLAVA

This morning, we have time for Mass, and a morning of reflection on the ship with Fr. Michael. Enjoy lunch on the ship, as we arrive in Bratislava at 4 PM, and more great food awaits us at the town's Christmas markets. The ship is docked in the city center. Our guide will lead us to the main square, where we will have time to explore on our own. Walk back to the ship at any time you wish. Tonight, we have our farewell dinner on the ship with music and dancing. Overnight on the cruise. (B.L.D)


# December 2, Wednesday, DAY 6: VIENNA - MELK - SALZBURG WITH CLASSICAL MUSIC CONCERT


### **MS DOUCE FRANCE**

Completely renovated in 2017 according to the company's new standards, this ship now offers much more spacious cabins with large bay windows on the upper deck. The soft and feminine decoration mixes shades of pink with aubergine and anise colors in the common areas. The cabins evoke a marine atmosphere. Located on the upper deck, the lounge / bar (at the front) and the restaurant (at the rear) have wide panoramic windows. We are here to see the painted houses and visit the Monastery of Ettal, where we celebrate Mass. Next door to the monastery is the brewery where we learn about the

process monks use to make local beer. We settle into our comfortable hotel for dinner and overnight in the Oberammergau area. (B.D)

### **December 4, Friday, DAY 8: MUNICH**

Driving to Munich today, we take a small detour to see Neuschwanstein Castle (from the outside), which was the inspiration for Cinderella's Castle in Disney World. Upon arrival in Munich, we celebrate Mass and have a short walking tour of the city center. Enjoy the rest of the evening exploring the famous Munich Christmas markets. Overnight in Munich. (B)

#### December 5, Saturday, DAY 9: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flights home. (B)



**PILGRIMAGE PRICES:** Trip price is based on a minimum of 80 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. \*A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

**SOLO ROOM:** A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

**LAND-ONLY OPTION:** Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$750.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 121 days or more before departure. A \$1,000.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 120 and 90 days prior to departure. Within 90 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice.
