PRE-TOUR TO HUNGARY

Sunday, September 26, Day 1: DEPART USA

Monday, September 27, Day 2: BUDAPEST – ESZTERGOM – SZENTENDRE – GYÖR

Welcome to Hungary! Our English-speaking tour managers will meet us at the airport to begin a breathtaking panoramic tour of this divided city. From the comfort of our motorcoach, our exploration begins at City Park and the majestic Heroes' Square, where statues of iconic Hungarian leaders tell the story of a nation. We visit the awe-inspiring St. Stephen's Basilica, enjoy some free time for lunch in the bustling city center, and then celebrate Mass. Check-in at our hotel begins at 4 PM, leaving us time to rest or explore before our group welcome dinner with wine. Overnight in Budapest. **Meals: D Wine included** *We suggest a visit to the New York Cafe for coffee and dessert, as many consider it one of the most beautiful cafes in the world.

Thursday, September 30, Day 3: BUDAPEST – CRUISE EMBARKATION

In the afternoon, enjoy lunch and explore the city on our own or return to the ship for included lunch. Monday, October 4, Day 7: A DAY OF WINE AND ABBEYS - BIKING THROUGH THE COUNTRYSIDE

We are docked in the magnificent Wachau Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The village of Dürnstein is in the center of Austria's wine country. Take a walk to on our own to explore the many quaint wineries in the village and see the Baroque houses, the Rathouse, the Augustinian Monastery, and the Blue Monastery Church and Abbey. Our journey continues along the most beautiful stretch of the Danube as we sail past lush vineyards, fairy-tale castles, and ancient monasteries. Bicycling enthusiasts can take an optional 60-minute bike ride* along the Danube River. We stop at the magnificent Benedictine Abbey of Melk for Mass and to learn about the life of the monks who live here. Enjoy a relaxing dinner on the ship, followed by drinks and music in the lounge. Overnight on the ship. **Meals: B.L.D** *The optional 60 minute bike ride is \$85.00 per person and includes a bike, safety helmet, and a guide.

Tuesday, October 5, Day 8: THE ART AND MUSIC OF LINZ – PASSAU

Today, we have a choice to stay on the ship all day and relax, perhaps get a massage or enjoy reading a book, or take a walking tour of Linz, followed by a visit to St. Florian Monastery. Our day starts with Mass in Linz, Austria's cultural capital. We visit the New Cathedral, also known as the Mariendom, the largest church in Austria, with a seating capacity of 20,000. Inside, we admire the gorgeous interior design, featuring a majestic altar, crypts, hand-carved wooden details, and exquisite stained-glass windows, some of which depict Linz's history. Following lunch, we take our buses for a short drive up the hill to visit St. Florian Monastery to explore its royal apartments, galleries, and library. We are in for a treat after the visit, as we are attending a private music concert. Tonight, enjoy an opportunity to get dressed up for the Captain's dinner, followed by music in the lounge. Overnight on the ship.

Wednesday, October 6, Day 9: REGENSBURG: THE CITY OF POPE BENEDICT

This morning, we arrive in Passau and drive to Regensburg to explore one of Germany's best-preserved medieval cities, famous for sausage-making and for being where Pope Benedict grew up, studied, and became a priest. We embark on a walking tour of the city, highlighting places the Holy Father visited in his youth. We see the Stone Bridge, St. Peter's Cathedral, the Basilica of Our Lady - known as the oldest Catholic place of worship in Bavaria, St. Emmeram's Basilica, and more. Lunch is not included for those that go to Regensburg. We suggest having the famous wurst sausage that Regensburg is known for. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight on the ship. **Meals: B.D**

Thursday, October 7, Day 10: DISEMBARKATION IN PASSAU – PRAGUE

We disembark this morning and proceed to Prague. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at Strahov Monastery, then make our way to the massive Prague Castle. Step inside the castle's protective walls and enter a self-contained city with courtyards, palaces, towers, churches, and gardens designed for kings and emperors, and housing and workplaces for all those who tended the rulers. We see the lofty St. Vitus Cathedral, which took 600 years to complete, and Vladislav Hall, whose complex stone-vaulting system was among the most advanced engineering feats of the late Middle Ages. Settle into our hotel. Dinner is at leisure to explore the city on our own. Overnight in Prague. **Meals: B**

Friday, October 8, Day 11: PRAGUE: INFANT JESUS OF PRAGUE

Our day in Prague starts with Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Victories, where we see the statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague (TBC). Our city tour gives us an overview as we drive past the State Opera House, the National Museum, and Wenceslas Square. After strolling through Golden Lane, a street of quaint cottages where Prague's 17th-century goldsmiths lived, we take our bus to the picturesque Lesser Quarter, the district around the castle, to Charles Bridge. Enjoy a lunch break in one of the many cafes and time at leisure to explore this area on our

own. See the Old Town Square, Prague's most famous Gothic church, Our Lady Before Týn, along with the 14th-century Old Town Hall (which boasts a famous medieval astronomical clock), the beautiful baroque St. Nicholas, the rococo Kinsky Palace, and a group of Renaissance houses. Although today we will be walking more than usual, the beautiful city of Prague cannot be seen by bus, so we must put on our most comfortable shoes and prepare for extended walking. Tonight we have our farewell dinner at a local brewery. Overnight in Prague.

Meals: B. Special dinner

Saturday, October 9, Day 12: PRAGUE – USA

This morning, after breakfast, we head to the airport for our flights back to the USA. **Meals: B**

Saturday, October 9, Day 12: PRAGUE – KRAKOW

We depart for Krakow this morning, crossing from the Czech Republic into Poland. Upon arrival, check into our hotel and enjoy time at leisure in one of the most beautiful European cities. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Krakow. **Meals: B.D**

Sunday, October 10, Day 13: KRAKÓW SITES – DIVINE MERCY – HAVE NO FEAR CENTER

Our sightseeing tour of Krakow includes stops in the Medieval Old Town and on Wawel Hill, where we see the Cathedral and the St. Stanislaus Shrine, which contains the relics of Poland's patron saint. We see the Pope's room and the famous Pope's Window honoring St. John Paul II. We travel a short distance to visit the Divine Mercy Shrine, where St. Faustina, the Apostle of Divine Mercy, lived and died. We celebrate Mass at the Divine Mercy Shrine (TBC) and visit the "Have No Fear Center," dedicated to St. John Paul II, to venerate his relics. Dinner is at leisure tonight to enjoy one of the many restaurants in Central Market Square, the largest medieval square in Europe. Overnight in Krakow. **Meals: B**

Monday, October 11, Day 14: CZESTOCHOWA

Today, we visit Jasna Gora Monastery to see the miraculous icon of the Black Madonna. We celebrate Mass and explore the monastery. Time for prayer and reflection is scheduled. Return to Krakow for dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Krakow. **Meals: B.D**

Tuesday, October 12, Day 15: AUSCHWITZ – WADOWICE

This morning, we visit the infamous concentration camp at Auschwitz and see the cell of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Following our included lunch, we visit the hometown of St. John Paul II, where we see his home, which is now a fabulous museum, and the church next door where he was baptized. Return to Krakow for our farewell dinner, including a wonderful, fun folklore show. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in Krakow.

Meals: B. L. Farewell dinner with folklore show

Wednesday, October 13, Day 16: DEPART FOR USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flights home. **Meals: B**

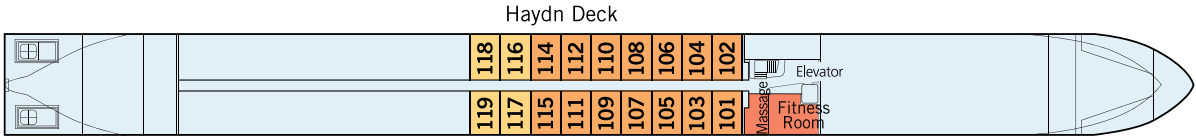
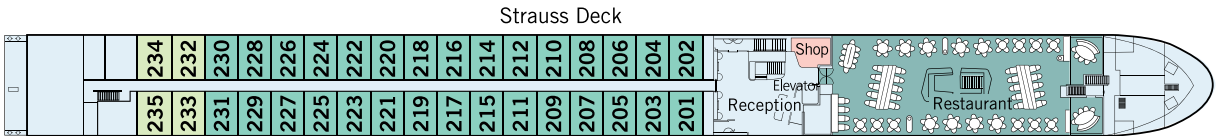
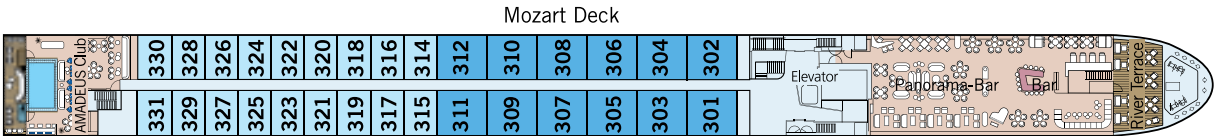
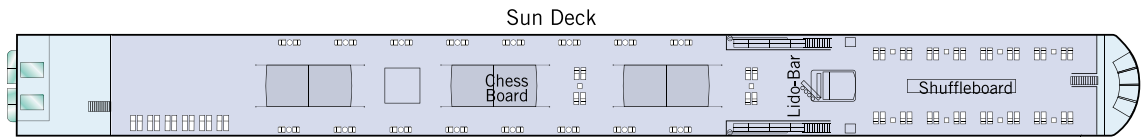
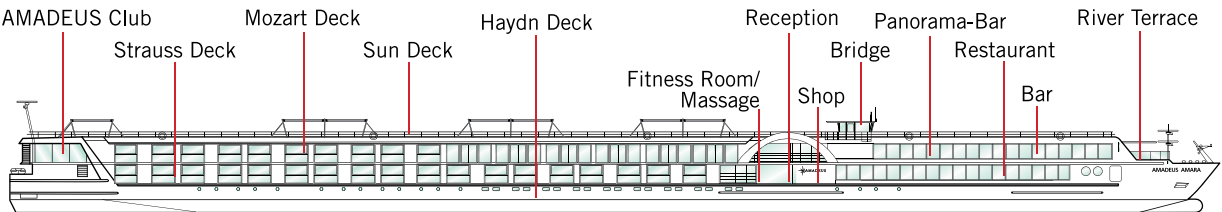
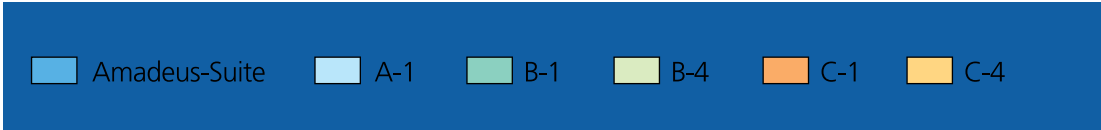
