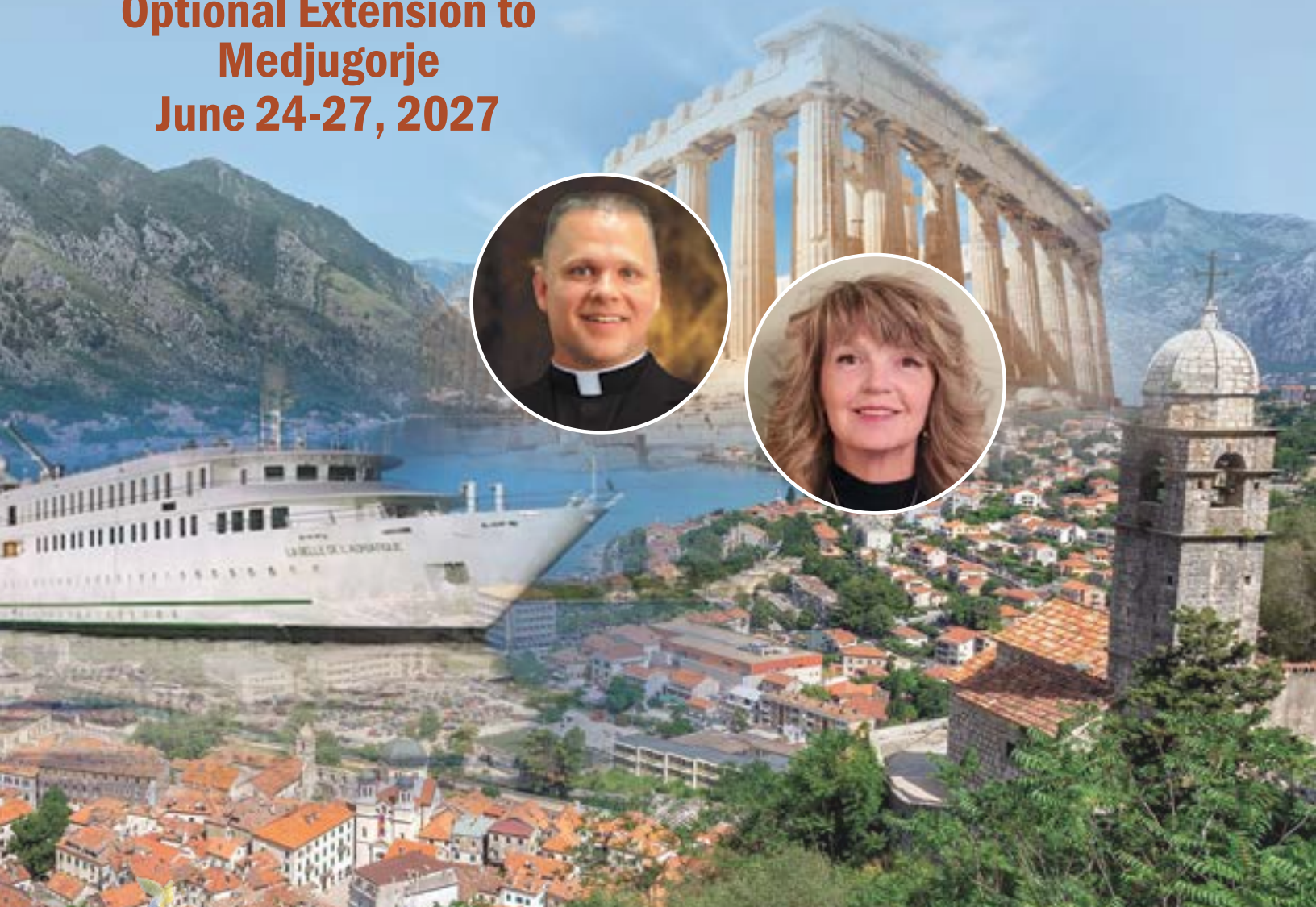

June 15, Tuesday, Day 1: DEPART USA – OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO ATHENS

We depart on an overnight flight to Athens, Greece, the starting point of this pilgrimage cruise that will carry us across the Aegean and Adriatic Seas in the footsteps of St. Paul, through the sanctuaries of Meteora, and into the historic port cities of Montenegro and Croatia. Quotes for optional upgrades to Premium Economy or Business Class, along with add-on flights from other cities, are available upon request beginning approximately 120 days before departure. Because we work with group airfares, we cannot accommodate individual seat requests. If specific seats are important to your travel experience, please book your own airfare, and we will book the land package for you. If you choose the land-only option, please be sure you are at the airport to meet the group; we will provide you with group flight info once you have registered.

June 16, Wednesday, Day 2: ARRIVE ATHENS – MARS HILL – EMBARKATION

We arrive in Athens, Greece, and our English-speaking local guides welcome us. We transfer into the city to celebrate our opening Mass at the Catholic Cathedral of Athens, dedicated to St. Dionysius the Areopagite. Nearby, we climb the ancient rock of the Areopagus, known as Mars Hill, where St. Paul once addressed Athens' philosophers and proclaimed the God unknown to them. Enjoy lunch on your own in the Old City of Plaka, with its many tavernas and cafes, before a panoramic drive past the Acropolis and the Temple of Olympian Zeus. We then transfer to the port to board our ship, the MV La Belle de l'Adriatique, a small four-deck vessel. We settle into our cabins and gather for a welcome cocktail with the Captain and crew. Dinner is served onboard as we set sail this evening. Beverages including wine, beer, soft drinks,

coffee and tea are included on this cruise. Dinner and overnight on the ship. **Meals: D**

June 17, Thursday, Day 3: ATHENS – ACROPOLIS – CORINTH CANAL

This morning we return ashore for a guided tour of the Acropolis and the Parthenon, the enduring symbol of ancient Athens, taking in the view over the city from its summit. In the early afternoon we reboard the ship for the included lunch. We enjoy time at leisure on the deck as we sail through the narrow and dramatic Corinth Canal, a passage carved through solid rock connecting the Aegean and Ionian Seas. As we sail toward Corinth, we celebrate Mass onboard, reflecting on St. Paul's letters to the Corinthians and his ministry among the early Christian community he founded in the city we will soon visit. Following Mass, we hear a talk from Fr. Alar. Then gather on deck to watch the canal transit before an evening of leisure aboard. Our cruise includes nightly entertainment. Dinner and overnight on the ship. **Meals: B, L, D**

June 18, Friday, Day 4: BIBLICAL CORINTH – NEMEA WINERY & GREEK WINE TASTING

After breakfast, we board our buses to visit Ancient Corinth, including the Bema, the raised judgment seat where St. Paul once stood before the Roman proconsul Gallio and spent a year and a half preaching to the young Christian community he founded there. Here we celebrate Mass. Then continue into the countryside of Nemea, one of the oldest and most celebrated wine regions in Greece, and stop at a local winery for a wine tasting. We return to the ship for an afternoon of relaxation and socializing. Dinner and overnight on the ship. **Meals: B, Picnic lunch provided by the ship, D**

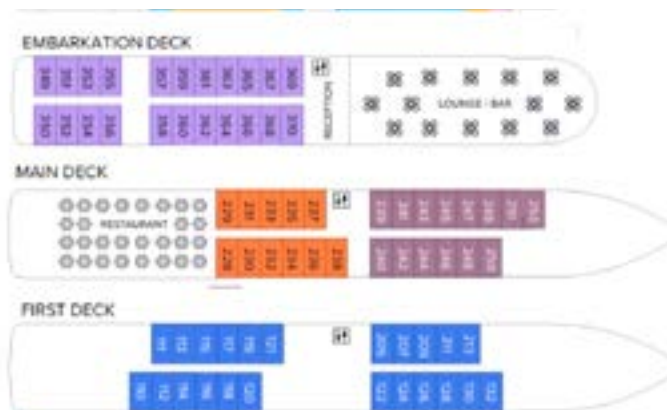
MV La Belle de l'Adriatique



Renovated in 2017, the MV La Belle de l'Adriatique offers a contemporary and welcoming setting for exploring the Mediterranean and Adriatic coasts. Its aqua green and brass tones create an elegant, sunny atmosphere. This intimate four-deck ship docks in the heart of cities and can accommodate 197 passengers.

Cabins on the upper and boarding decks feature large windows, while those on the main and lower decks are designed with portholes. The main deck restaurant serves all meals in a refined setting, while the piano bar invites guests to unwind with a cocktail, browse the library, listen or play the piano, or simply relax with the TV. The panoramic lounge, located on the boarding deck, includes a bar and dance floor for lively evenings. On the expansive sun deck, two jacuzzis and comfortable loungers provide the perfect setting to relax while enjoying panoramic sea views.

June 19, Saturday, Day 5: ITEA – OSIOS LOUKAS MONASTERY – OLIVE OIL TASTING

Docking at Itea, we drive into the hills of Boeotia to the Monastery of Osios Loukas, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the finest surviving examples of Byzantine art in Greece, treasured for its glittering mosaics and its chapel honoring the tenth-century hermit St. Luke of Steiris. We take time here for quiet prayer and reflection. Afterward, we visit a family-run olive oil facility in this celebrated growing region for a tour and tasting of estate olive oil, a fitting glimpse into the everyday life and land of the Greek countryside. We return to the ship this afternoon and celebrate Mass onboard. **Meals: B, Bagged lunch, D**

June 20, Sunday, Day 6: IGOUENITSA – MONASTERIES OF METEORA

Today is a long but beautiful day. We start the day early with Mass onboard the ship. You may choose to remain on the ship and explore the town on your own or visit the incredible Meteora Monasteries. After docking at Igoumenitsa, we take a 2-hour drive to Meteora, one of the great wonders of Christian monasticism, where sixteenth-century monasteries rise improbably atop towering rock pillars. We visit a monastery that is still active (be prepared for stairs and uphill climbing), learning of the monks and nuns who have preserved lives of prayer here for centuries. A bagged lunch is included during our excursion. We stop at an icon-making workshop to see how icons are painted and to purchase souvenirs which will remind us of our trip. Then return to Igoumenitsa, reboard the ship in time for dinner, and watch the beautiful Greek coastline as we set sail toward Montenegro. **Meals: B, Bagged lunch, D**

June 21, Monday, Day 7: BAY OF KOTOR – OUR LADY OF THE ROCKS

You will want to be up early this morning as our ship sails into the Bay of Kotor, often called Europe's southernmost fjord and one of the most

dramatic coastlines on the Adriatic Sea. We disembark and board a smaller local boat which takes us to visit Our Lady of the Rocks, a small manmade islet near Perast crowned by a Catholic church built on a site where, according to tradition, sailors piled stones after finding an icon of the Virgin Mary on a rock in the sea. We continue to the walled town of Kotor for a guided tour of its old streets, concluding with Mass at the Catholic Cathedral of St. Tryphon, seat of the Diocese of Kotor since the twelfth century, before returning to the ship for dinner and overnight. **Meals: B, L, D**

June 22, Tuesday, Day 8: SAILING TO DUBROVNIK – RETREAT AT SEA

Today we enjoy a Retreat Day onboard, as the ship sails along the Adriatic coast toward Dubrovnik. Mass is celebrated this morning, followed by talks and reflections led by Fr. Chris Alar and the other priests traveling with our group. Space for confession, prayer, and contemplation will be offered, as we take in all we have experienced so far on this pilgrimage. Enjoy free time to rest, take in the coastal scenery from the deck, and enjoy the company of fellow pilgrims. One of the most beautiful sights we'll see from the ship is the Old Town of Dubrovnik, with its walls and fortress. This evening, we'll get dressed up for the Captain's Dinner. **Meals: B, L, D**

June 23, Wednesday, Day 9: DUBROVNIK OLD TOWN

We spend the day exploring Dubrovnik, the pearl of the Adriatic, with its massive stone walls and marble streets. Our guided tour includes Dubrovnik Cathedral, dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, where we celebrate Mass. We walk the length of the old city walls and the main street, the Stradun, with free time in the afternoon to explore on our own before returning to the ship for our final evening aboard.

Meals: B, L, D



June 24, Thursday, Day 10: DISEMBARK IN DUBROVNIK - RETURN HOME OR CONTINUE TO MEDJUGORJE

After a final breakfast on the ship, we disembark in Dubrovnik. Guests returning home transfer to the airport for their return flights. Guests continuing on the optional extension transfer by motor coach across the border into Bosnia and Herzegovina, arriving in Medjugorje in time to have lunch, settle into our hotel, and join the Rosary and Mass at St. James Church. Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje.

OPTIONAL EXTENSION IN MEDJUGORJE

June 25, Friday, Day 11: MEDJUGORJE – APPARITION HILL - ST. JAMES CHURCH

Our first full day in Medjugorje begins with Mass at St. James Church, the heart of parish life here since 1981. We climb Apparition Hill, the rocky path where the visionaries first reported seeing Our Lady, praying the Rosary along the way. The afternoon is left free for confession and personal prayer in this holy place, with its many chapels and quiet

corners for reflection. We will meet with the visionaries if they are in the village. Tonight we gather again for dinner and a time of sharing. Overnight in Medjugorje. **Meals: B, D**

June 26, Saturday, Day 12: MEDJUGORJE – HOLY CROSS MOUNTAIN – ADORATION

We climb Holy Cross Mountain, site of the large concrete cross erected in 1933, taking in sweeping views over the Medjugorje valley. Mass is celebrated in the parish, followed by time for Eucharistic Adoration and Confession, both central to the spiritual rhythm of this town. The balance of the day is at leisure for personal prayer, shopping for religious articles, or simply resting after a full pilgrimage. Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje. **Meals: B, D**

June 27, Sunday, Day 13: MEDJUGORJE – RETURN HOME

After an early breakfast, we transfer by motor coach to the airport for our return flight, carrying home the graces of this pilgrimage across land and sea. **Meals: B**

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 45 passengers per bus. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$750.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 121 days or more before departure. A \$1,000.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 120 and 91 days prior to departure. Within 90 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 90 days before departure).
